

I am 19 years of age and left school at 16. I did one year at college on a foundation course and then went to a different college for two years to learn about animal management care. I started at Lighthouse Futures Trust in September 2024. I came to here because I wanted to get experience and have an opportunity to get a job and also learn the skills to apply for a job

I heard about Lighthouse Futures Trust through a relative and thought it sounded interesting and useful. Lighthouse Futures Trust looked like it could prepare me for work and get me into a job. Also, it felt very welcoming.

At work I work on reception as an assistant, and I print documents from a computer which I send to patients. I have a work buddy if I need assistance but overall I do the work by myself. I work four days a week for approximately five hours a day. I go to college in Headingly for one day a week.

I don't have to wear a uniform but clothes must be appropriate for an office environment.

I think the internship is fantastic for those who really want to get into a role and for gaining an insight into what work is like. The course leaders like to push you to do your best, but they won't throw you in a t the deep end. They are there to help me if I need them.

My job coach is Jak. He likes me to try new things and to grow and to be independent.

I have recently done some travel training to help me travel by bus to the college in Headingley. This has helped me gain independence to travel by myself.
